FALL PROTECTION - ELIMINATING FALLS

Learn to identify conditions and behaviors that cause falls:

Stairways

- Carrying objects that block the view of the steps
- Running
- Failure to use handrail
- Working in areas cluttered by objects
- Inattention



Ladders

- Use of ladders that do not suit the job
- Use of ladders that are in poor condition
- Improper ladder placement
- Improper ladder use
- Reaching/leaning too far
- Using a ladder that is too short

Scaffolds

- Using scaffolds without guard rails or toe boards
- Using poorly constructed scaffolds
- Using scaffolds without bracing to prevent sway
- Rushing work

Floor Openings

- Working around uncovered floor openings
- Working near floor openings that have been insufficiently covered
- Working around floor openings that have been insufficiently marked

Wall Openings

- Failing to ensure that wall openings are barricaded
- Working near wall openings that may break easily
- Failing to tie-off when working near exposed wall openings or on roof-tops without adequate height parapet walls
